YANKEE GRC Membership

The application procedure to become a voting member of YANKEE GOLDEN RETRIEVER CLUB is as follows:

- 1. Prospective members must attend two YANKEE meetings prior to becoming eligible for a full, voting membership. Club meetings are on the fourth Tuesday of odd-number months, earlier in November, usually at the Acton Congregational Church. Copies of the club constitution and Bylaws are available at each meeting.
- 2. A completed membership application, signed by two **YANKEE** members in good standing, and the membership dues for one year must be submitted to the membership chair.
- 3. Upon completion of the membership requirements, the membership chair will present the application for a vote at the next club meeting. All membership requirements must be completed within one year of application, or the application will expire and must be resubmitted.

Non-members can subscribe to the **YANKEE GRC** newsletter, *Finish Lines*.

Complete the front page of the membership application and send it with the fee of \$25 to the membership chair.

Please note: Article 1 of the **YANKEE** bylaws states in part: During the month of November, a dues statement, payable on the first of February of the following year, shall be mailed to each club member. No members may vote who have not paid their dues for the current year. A membership will be considered as lapsed and automatically terminated if a member's dues remain unpaid 90 days after the first day of the fiscal year, *i.e.*, April 1. A \$10 late fee will be applied to any payments made after February 1.

Lapsed memberships are ineligible to vote, receive trophies, list wins in *Finish Lines*, list litters with Breeders' Referral, *etc.* To re-join the club, the complete procedure described above must be followed.

MINUTE BY MINUTE

The YANKEE GOLDEN RETRIEVER CLUB Board of Directors met in Boxborough MA on 7/5/05. Business and committee reports are summarized below.

Correspondence: AKC issued seven new policies regarding club activities and events.

Agility: July trials at the Sports Zone in Derry NH are full. Confirmation letters have been sent and are on the Web site. Barbara Budnar, AKC Field Rep, will be attending our trial.

Breeder referral: Still need to get the new breeder referral write-up on the Web ite. Want to clarify that **YGRC** is not an enforcement organization; breeder referral is offered only as a service to our members and the public.

Concessions: PayPal investigations continuing. Limited inventory of **YANKEE** merchandise. Suggestion to sell remaining items at events, and not activate the on-line store until restocked. Agreed to terminate our credit card service.

Field: The Field Committee voted that **YGRC**'s position is that the Master National remain an AKC event. The premium for the August Hunt Test is on the Web site.

Membership: Discussed applicants that need sponsors. AKC now requires an electronic file of our membership list.

Newsletter: June-July issue at printers. Discussed the need to educate event chairs to be sure that someone is recording results and to get results to the editors in a timely manner.

Programs: July 26 program is the ice cream social. September program meeting is moved to 9/20 to avoid conflict with the GRCA National.

Puppy Kindergarten: Next class starts 9/8.

Tracking: Need tracklayers for TD/TDX in September.

Trophy: Retired the match trophies. Remind the membership of the change in the requirements for the annual trophies — must work at least one **YGRC** event to be eligible to earn a trophy.

Web site: Still working the kinks out, but making great strides in using our Web site and keeping it up to date. Need to schedule a Web committee meeting to work out details.

Other business:

- AKC Public Education: Still looking for volunteer. Discussed some possible candidates.
- Clinics: Heart clinic scheduled for 9/13. Would like to schedule the Fall eye clinic for the same date, if possible.
- MassFed/Legislative watch: YGRC's representative requested the club take a position opposing the PAWS legislation.

Recently Approved Resolutions:

RESOLUTION 05-62: Authorizing replacement of eight member club banners lost at the 2004 National Specialty.

RESOLUTION 05-63: Donating the \$2,000 donation received from Discovery Communications. following the People's Choice award at the AKC/Eukanuba Championship Dog Show held in January, 2005, to the general fund of the Golden Retriever Foundation to be used where needed most.

RESOLUTION 05-65: Discontinuing the Golden Effort Member (GEM) Award.

RESOLUTION 05-66: Authorizing publication of the 2005 Puppy Referral Manual which will be made available to all GRCA member and provisional club puppy referral volunteers.

RESOLUTION 05-67: Retiring the *Ch. Amberac's Asterling Aruba* trophy and accepting donation of the *Am. Can. Ch. Mariner Lil Sister By Tempo SDHF* trophy to be presented to the winner of the Brood Bitch class at the 2005 GRCA National Specialty.

RESOLUTION 05-73: Adopting the following themes for the designated issues of the magazine: January/February, National Specialty coverage; March/April, Stud Dog/Brood Bitch; May/June, Performance Dogs; July/August, Young Hopefuls/Promising

Puppies; September/October, Veterans; November/December, different theme each year.

Hot Topics:

DWAA will be offering a Junior Educational Award annually. This is separate from the Junior Award given as part of the writing contest. Amounts of \$500 to \$1000 will be awarded directly to recipients. Applicants must be

18 to 22 years old. One to three applicants will be chosen yearly by a committee of DWAA members.

The Board is considering adding a new committee chair to the roster—that of Legislative Liaison, in accordance with the guidelines sent by AKC. While GRCA has to be careful about actually lobbying for legislation, the club could have a position that would act as a funnel for information. This is still in the planning stages.

Thanks to the efforts of Chris Miele and Howard Falberg, AKC has now issued a directive that applies to *all* parent clubs. A National is considered one event, even though separate venues have individual event numbers. Superintendents have been instructed to make the catalog available on the first day of any national event.

PAWS legislation: The board discussed the proposed PAWS legislation, which would cause breeders of 7 or more litters of dogs & cats to be licensed and regulated by the USDA. AKC has come out in favor of the proposed legislation without asking for input from member clubs. There was much discussion as to whether the board should take a position on the legislation, without knowing how the membership feels on the issue. The board decided to take a position as the Board of Directors of YGRC not as the club itself.

MOTION 07/05-01—The Board of Directors of **YANKEE GOLDEN RETRIEVER CLUB** oppose the proposed PAWS Legislation and will notify the AKC, the GRCA, and the appropriate legislative delegations of our opposition. Made by Jan Bramhall and seconded by Donna Morgan. The motion passed 5 to 2. Letter to be written and circulated.

- GRCA 2008 National Specialty: Discussed possibility of YANKEE hosting the GRCA National Specialty in 2008. Board members reported on discussions with event committees. The board is split on whether or not to proceed with discussions with GRCA. The major sticking points are the location for field events, Southern Berkshire GRC's willingness to run the field trial, and finding a YANKEE member willing to chair conformation.
- Golden Retriever News: We need to do a better job of getting Yankee events listed in the calendar of the GR News. Will find out how we can get the entire YANKEE calendar reported to GRCA.



YANKEE recommends that a fully executed, written purchase agreement setting forth all the terms of purchase be obtained before pos-session of a puppy is transferred to a purchaser. YGRC members may list litters, older puppies, and adult dogs with the Breeders' Referral Listing and in Finish Lines if the breeder has been a member of YGRC or another GRCAmember club for a minimum of one year, and submits the following:

- Copies of AKC registration certificates, thereby verifying that both the sire and dam were over two years old at the time of breeding.
- Eye clearances on both the sire and dam, issued by a veterinary ophthalmologist who is certified by the American College of Veterinary Ophthalmologists. Clearances must be current during the time the litter is listed. Eye clearances on dogs under 8 years of age are valid only for one year from the date of issue. CERF certificates will be accepted.
- Hip clearances on both the sire and dam. Dogs must have final OFA Certification or PennHip Distraction Indexes below the median done at or after 6 months of age, with no radio-graphic evidence of hip dysplasia.
- Final heart clearances on both the sire and dam, issued by a veterinary cardiologist who is certified by the ACVIM (cardiology).
- A Litter Listing Agreement, completed and signed for each litter listed.
