The test secretary will notify entrants as soon as practicable, via email, that their entry has been received. Entrants should contact the test secretary if they have sent an entry and not received confirmation of its arrival.

A DRAWING for entry numbers will be held on Wednesday, July 30, 2014, at 7:00 PM at the Test Secretary's home. This test is open to all breeds. FROM THE NORTH & SOUTH: From I-95 take exit 4, Spaulding Turnpike, Routes 4 West and 16 North (left exit from the south). Just before the Dover toll booth, take exit # 6W, Rte. 4 West towards Durham and Concord. There are three Durham exits (the second exit is a light at Madbury Rd). Take the last exit, Route 155A UNH, Durham, and turn left at the bottom of the ramp onto 155A east.
