FROM THE NORTH & SOUTH: From I-95 take exit 4, Spaulding Turnpike, Routes 4 West and 16 North (left exit from the south). Just before the toll booths, take Exit 6W on the right, Route 4 West towards Durham and Concord. Follow Route 4 almost seven miles to the exit for Route 155A UNH, Durham. Turn left at the bottom of the ramp onto 155A East and travel just over a mile, through the traffic rotary. Just past the hill over the railroad tracks, take a sharp left onto Depot Rd, adjacent to the large artificial turf athletic field. Proceed 50 yards to the Dairy Bar. Observe all speed limits in Durham!

CLOSING DATE: 6:00 P.M. Wednesday, July 23, 2025 at the Test Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, canceled, altered, or substituted.

The US postal office has recently changed their service standards. Please allow sufficient mailing time to ensure your entry arrives before the closing.

As required by the AKC Tracking Regulations, Amended to July 1, 2023, a written certification must accompany the TDU entry for any dog which has not previously passed an AKC TD or TDU test.

In accordance with Chapter 1, Section 12 of the Tracking Regulations, the Test Secretary may enter and handle a dog that she owns or co-owns.

In accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17d of the Tracking Regulations, 2 tracks will be set aside for entrants using Test Worker Credits.

This TDU/VST Test is open to all breeds, with preference given to Golden Retrievers. If required by the numbers and types of entries, there will be multiple drawings for TDU and VST. The drawings for entries and alternates will be conducted in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 17d of the AKC Tracking Regulations, *Draw Order with Worker Option in Specialty Tracking Tests* as indicated in the following paragraph.

Draw Order with Worker Option in Specialty Tracking Tests

- 1. Worker Option for non-titled specialty breed
- 2. Non-titled specialty breed
- 3. Worker Option for titled specialty breed (if worker option tracks are still available)
- 4. Titled specialty breed
- 5. Worker Option for non-titled "other" breeds (if worker option tracks are still available)
- 6. Non-titled "other" breeds
- 7. Worker Option for titled "other" breeds (if worker option tracks are still available)
- 8. Titled "other" breed

The drawing will take place at the test secretary's home at 7:00 P.M. on Wednesday, July 23, 2025 or as soon as practicable thereafter. After the entry limit is reached in either TDU or VST, an alternate list will be prepared with positions assigned according to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entrants of the results of the draw by e-mail as soon as practicable after the draw and within 48 hours.

All entrants submitting certifications should enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope so that unused certifications may be returned. If you would like your entry and check returned in the event it is unused, please enclose a self-addressed stamped envelope; otherwise all such entries and checks will be shredded.

TRACK EXCHANGE POLICY: In the event that the limit for entries is not reached for TDU or VST, and the limit for entries is exceeded in either TDU or VST, tracks may be exchanged using the factor of 2 TDU = 1 VST as specified in Chapter 1, Section 19 of the AKC Tracking Regulations.

WITHDRAWALS: If an entry withdraws for any reason between the closing date and the test date, and is replaced by an alternate, the entry fee will be refunded. The entry fee for an alternate who does not participate will be refunded within seven days after the test. Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary.

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations after all other dogs and bitches have been tested. They will be allowed on the tracking area only immediately prior to the running of their tracks. Please notify the Test Secretary as soon as you know your bitch is in season for this test.

PLEASE NOTE: Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

- 2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed.
